For visitors who wish to travel up to Belaga from Kapit, one express boat departs daily at 0900 (please check in advance) from Kapit. The journey takes about 4-5 hours and one-way fares range from RM30.00-RM35.00. Foreign visitors to Belaga are required to apply a [tourist permit](#) at [Kapit Resident's Office](#).

However, Belaga is not accessible by express boats during the dry season or when the water level is low (please check in advance). Visitors are advised to wear life jackets as the boats will pass through notorious Pelagus Rapids and a number of smaller sets of rapids before reaching Belaga. Air link to Belaga is not available at the moment. Nevertheless, to really see and enjoy the Batang Rejang, visitors are encouraged to travel by boat.
